



While presenting your selection for the Speech Meet, focus on the following points:

- ✓ Introduce yourself to the judges
- ✓ Stand up straight
- ✓ Speak clearly and loudly enough for everyone to hear you
- ✓ Put energy and feeling into your speaking
- ✓ Use your hands and facial expressions to help create the tone or message the author of the piece may have intended
- ✓ Make eye contact and do not look at the floor
- ✓ Do not keep your hands in your pockets
- ✓ Keep reciting even if you've forgotten a word or sentence
- ❖ Bible verses are to be followed by what you think the verses mean.
- Historical Oration presenters must make eye contact periodically during the reading.
- Song Lyrics are to be followed by what message you believe the artist is trying to convey to the listener.
- Poems may be followed by what you believe the author is trying to tell the reader, however, it is not mandatory for you to do so for this category.
